What is Van Deventer-Maas Scholarship?

Van Deventer-Maas Scholarship is a scholarship funded by a private foundation that has a mission to support the education of young talented Indonesian students

The foundation was established in 1947, pursuant to the last provision and the "will" of Mrs. Elizabeth Maas, the widow of Mr. Coen van Deventer

In 1979, Van Deventer-Maas Stichting merged with Tjandi Stichting (founded in 1913) and Van Deventer Stichting (founded in 1917), thereby absorbing the Kartini Foundation, which had been founded in 1913

On September 12th, 2017, the representative office in Indonesia was formally established to be Yayasan Van Deventer-Maas Indonesia (YVDMI)

The couple, Coen van Deventer and Elisabeth Maas, have decided to dedicate their whole wealth for the personal development of young Indonesians. One of the given supports is the scholarship for young talented Indonesian students, mostly for those came from underprivileged family.

Duration of Support

The scholarships application can be done in the first year of study $(2^{nd} \text{ semester})$ and last up to the standard duration of the study $(S1 = 1^{st} - 4^{th} \text{ year})$, D3 = $1^{st} - 3^{rd} \text{ year}$) with the following terms and conditions: The fund will not be delivered for those who: [1] underperformed during the period of the scholarship (IPK < 3.00), [2] on leave, [3] no confirmation upon the receipt of the fund and [4] no news within a certain period of time.

The Scholarship Requirements

- 1. Students of S1 and D3
- 2. Maximum 27 years old
- Financially deprived (stated in Surat Keterangan Tidak Mampu (SKTM) and/or Recommendation Letter of Financial Condition issued by the University)
- 4. IPK > 3.00 in the previous semesters
- Disciplines: Accounting, Agriculture, Fishery/Animal Husbandry, Architecture, Arts and Cultures, Arts and Design, Biology, Chemistry, Communication, Economics, Education, Psychology, Engineering, English, Financial Management, Forestry, Geography, Sociology, Anthropology, Health/Medicine, History, Hotel Management, Informatics, Information Technology/ICT, Management, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Technic/Technology
- 6. Active in organizations and or social-communities
- 7. Proficient in English will be advantage

Amount of Scholarship and Benefits

- Rp. 650.000,- will be transferred directly to the grantees' bank account every month on the same date (not applicable due to Saturday/Sunday and Public Holiday)
- One-time TOEFL Bonus (if any) and Graduation Exam Bonus
- Opportunities to join VDMI Capacity Building programs (fully covered)

Application Process

Van Deventer-Maas Scholarship enrolment must be completed online through ers.vdms-scholarship.org. The checklist form of the required documents can be downloaded after completing the online registration. Invitation to continue to the second step of the selection process will be sent via email to the successful applicants. Finally, the complete required documents (hard copy) should be submitted to the Person in Charge (PIC) in applicants' universities.

Required Documents

- Surat Keterangan Tidak Mampu (SKTM) or Recommendation letter from the School/Department/University which stated that the applicants come from underprivileged families
- 2. The latest academic transcript with IPK (> 3.00)
- 3. Parents'/guardians' official income statement from their institutions (at least in the last 2 months). For Parents/guardians who work as entrepreneurs, the statement/letter can be made, signed, and sealed with Rp.6.000 meterai, and legalized by Kelurahan
- 4. Copies of ID (KTM and KTP)
- 5. Copy of Family Card (KK)
- 6. Pas Photo 4x6
- Copy of Bank Account (the front page which consisted the account holder number)
- 8. Electricity bill (at least in the last 2 months)
- 9. A personal statements (an essay about yourself including family, study, social activities, and the reason why you deserve a scholarship from VDMI, how the scholarship will help you if you are selected, and what will you do for societies after you received the scholarship.
 (Minimum 1,5 pages of A4, Font: Palatino Linotype, font size 11, and 1 spacing).

The university should send the documents to Van Deventer-Maas Indonesia Office in Yogyakarta to be selected in compliant with the above requirements. The agreement will be provided between the foundation and the university partners as well as between university partners and students to be signed upon approval.
